





## How can I give during this "stay at home" period?

You can give online through PayPal! This helps keep our elders safe by eliminating the need to go to the post office and to the bank. Here are four easy steps:


1. Go to <a href="https://www.arbordalechurch.org">www.arbordalechurch.org</a>. The screen that you will see will look like this, the picture may be different but the topics across the top will be the same:



2. Click on the yellow donate button at the top of the page and you will be directed to the PayPal donate page as shown below:



3. To give using a credit or debit card, simply enter the amount of the donation, then click on the "Donate with a Debit or Credit Card" button. You will be taken to a page to enter your credit or debit card information as shown below:
