A Year to Praise

In Psalm 51 David asks God to open his mouth so that his mouth might declare God's praise. This year we are praying that same prayer. We need God to open our hearts and our mouths to fill the whole sanctuary and all of Avery County with his praise.

To help us learn to sing more freely and fully we are going to focus on singing one hymn or song for each month. The hope is that can learn these hymns by heart and sing them from our hearts.

"Be Thou My Vision", our hymn for March, is a traditional Christian hymn of Irish origin. The words are based on a Middle Irish poem or prayer often attributed to the sixth-century Irish Christian poet St. Dallán Forgaill. The best-known English version was translated by Eleanor Hull and published in 1912. Since 1919 it has been commonly sung to an Irish folk tune, noted as "Slane."

The prayer belongs to a type known as a "lorica", a prayer for protection. The symbolic use of a battle-shield and a sword to invoke the power and protection of God draws on Saint Paul's Epistle to the Ephesians (Ephesians 6) which refers to "the shield of faith" and "the sword of the Spirit".


